

2024-2025 Faith Christian School Lunch Ordering Information

How and when do I order lunch? All lunch orders must be placed online via FACTS by noon on Friday of the preceding week. If we are not in school on any given Friday, the lunch orders are due on the Friday before that! Check "The Shield" and by clicking the calendar on the top of the right of the homepage on fcsva.com for these dates. Click here or scan the QR code for a tutorial on ordering lunches.

When do I pay? All lunch orders will be immediately charged to your debit or credit card when the order is placed via FACTS. If you do not get a confirmation email of your payment, then you have not paid.



Will the vendors provide extras to sell the "day of"? No.

Can I cancel my child's lunch order? There will be NO LUNCH CANCELLATIONS for the upcoming school year.

What if my child is sick/absent and had a lunch order? You will be given the option to donate the food or pick up your child's lunch order (after the vendor makes the delivery). If food is not donated, it will be labeled with your child's name and the date and placed in the Great Room refrigerator. Your Lower School child's food can be retrieved by a parent or staff member the next day of school. A Middle or Upper School student may retrieve their lunch from the Great Room refrigerator the next school day. Unretreived food will be discarded after one week. *Please fill out this form by scanning the QR code by Wednesday, August 21st.*



What if school is canceled? We will work with the vendor to change those orders to a different day.

What if my child forgets to bring lunch? The parent/guardian may bring lunch before the child's lunchtime. If that is not possible, Mrs. Smith and Mrs. Ridge have a limited supply of emergency lunches and will provide one to your student.
