

SAFETY AGREEMENT

- 1. Vehicles must have at least minimum insurance as required by the State of Virginia. As mandated by Virginia State law, both driver and owner of any motorized vehicle which is used must depend on his/her own insurance for the purpose of covering liability and damages. Both the owners and drivers of vehicles assume full legal and financial responsibilities for the operation of their vehicles and full legal and financial responsibilities of the safety of the passengers. The liability arising out of the use of a vehicle is the responsibility of the owner (first) and the operator (second). The school strongly encourages volunteers to drive only their own vehicles for school events.
- 2. Vehicles are to be in good working order.
- 3. Drivers are expected to obey all traffic regulations (especially speed and the wearing of seatbelts).
- 4. In case of emergency, the appropriate authorities (911) must first be contacted. The emergency is then to be reported to the FCS Front Desk (540) 769-5200
- 5. If drivers have cell phones the phone numbers should be exchanged among themselves in case of an emergency.
- 6. Drivers and chaperones are expected to maintain appropriate standards of behavior.
- 7. If students refuse to comply with safety concerns, the Head of Middle/Upper School or Head of Lower School Director must be informed.
